By purchasing a tour from the Mount Tabor Historical Society, you agree to abide by these policies. To ensure that we are providing a safe environment for all, the Society has the following protocols in place:



CDC-RECOMMENDED FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL VISITORS AND STAFF AT ALL TIMES WHILE INSIDE ANY BUILDING ON THE TOUR

CDC guidelines advise that face coverings should completely cover the mouth and nose, fitting snug against the side of the face.



SOCIAL DISTANCING IS ENCOURAGED

Visitors and staff are encouraged to keep at least 6 feet from others when possible.
